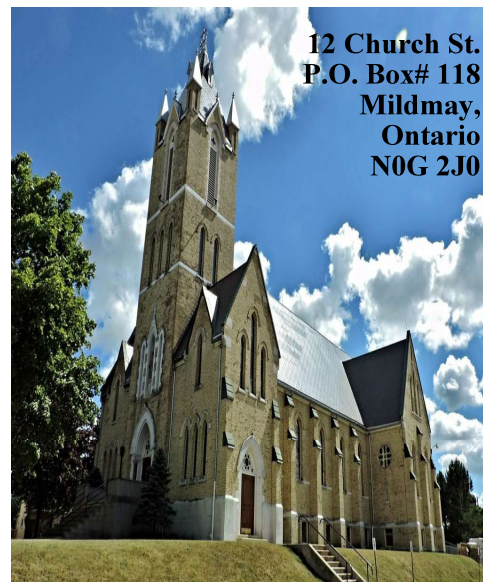

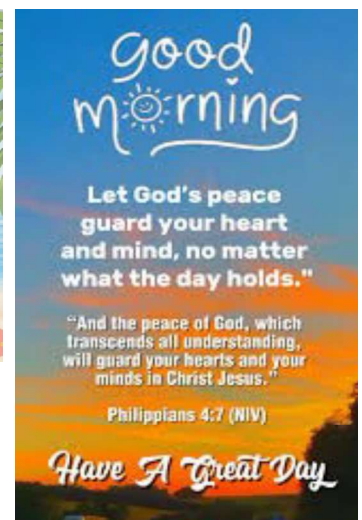

3. **CONTINGENCY BEQUEST:** Helps you leave a portion of your estate to Sacred Heart Parish if a named beneficiary does not survive you.

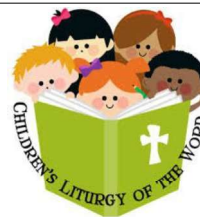

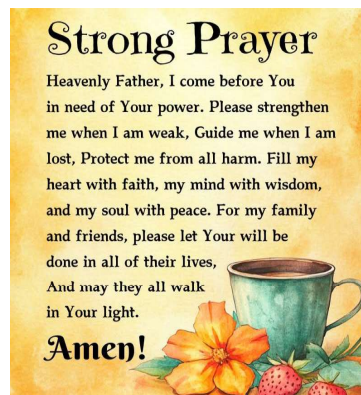

### Strong Prayer

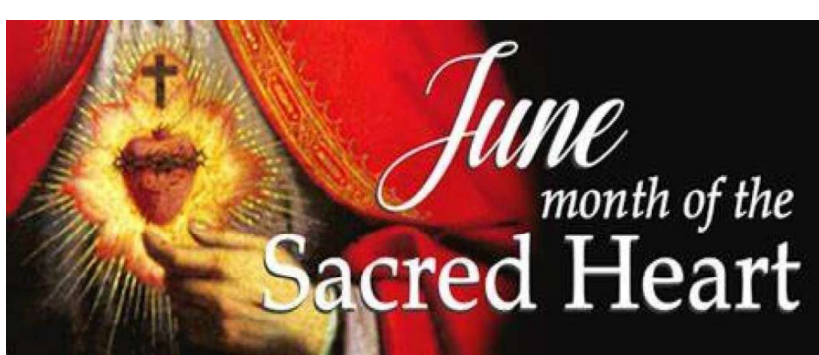

It is used in the offices and Masses of Ordinary Time.

As we begin to feel the warmth of summer, we can reflect that we celebrate the feasts of **THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD** (June 1), **THE PENTECOST SUNDAY** (June 8), **THE MOST HOLY TRINITY** (June 15), **THE MOST HOLY BODY and BLOOD** ([June 22](#)), **THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS** (June 27), **The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary** (June 28), **St. Barnabas** ([June 11](#)), **St. Anthony of Padua** (June 13), **St. Romuald** (June 19), **St. Aloysius Gonzaga** (June 21), **The Nativity of John the Baptist** (June 24), **Sts. Peter & Paul** (June 29).
